

Job Description – Automotive Assembly Technician

Summary Statement

The Automotive Assembly Technician assembles new production automobiles.

Description

The Automotive Assembly Technician assembles new production automobiles with new reproduction, OEM, and aftermarket parts, using proper tools and procedures. The Automotive Assembly Technician installs interior and exterior trim, glass and mechanisms, door and trunk closures, convertible top frames, weatherstrip, brake and fuel lines, wiring harnesses, HVAC systems, instrument panels and gauges, and other components.

Duties and Tasks Performed Critical to Success

The Automotive Assembly Technician must be proficient in fitting a variety of automobile parts to a painted vehicle body, while taking great care to protect the painted finish and all Class A surfaces. The Automotive Assembly Technician will work inside and around the vehicle, including under the dash and in confined spaces. The Automotive Assembly Technician must perform all tasks in a quality manner, in the proper sequence, in the time allotted. He/she will also assess, propose, and implement improvements to manufacturing methods and processes.
