

Job Description – Automotive Drivability Technician

Summary Statement

The Automotive Drivability Technician installs powertrain and chassis components, conducts quality assessments, and diagnoses and corrects drivability concerns on new production automobiles.

Description

The Automotive Drivability Technician assembles and installs various powertrain and chassis components including engines and transmissions and associated electronics, fuel systems, and chassis, brake, and steering components. The Automotive Drivability Technician diagnoses and corrects drivability and functional concerns on new production automobiles.

Duties and Tasks Performed Critical to Success

The Automotive Drivability Technician must be highly proficient in automotive powertrain, chassis, brakes, steering, and electrical systems with deep understanding of the interrelationships of various functional areas of an automobile. The Automotive Drivability Technician should have working understanding of vehicle dynamics and be capable of diagnosing concerns such as noise, vibration, and harshness (NVH).
