

Job Description – Automotive Electrical Technician

Summary Statement

The Automotive Electrical Technician assembles and installs electrical systems on new production automobiles.

Description

The Automotive Electrical Technician assembles and installs various components associated with the automotive electrical system, including body and powertrain wiring harnesses and control modules, HVAC systems, instrument panels and gauges, interior and exterior lighting, power windows and door locks, remote keyless entry systems, proximity key systems, entertainment systems, and other components.

Duties and Tasks Performed Critical to Success

The Automotive Electrical Technician must be proficient in automotive electrical systems and be capable of fitting a variety of automobile parts to a painted vehicle body, while taking great care to protect the painted finish and all Class A surfaces. The Automotive Electrical Technician will work inside and around the vehicle, including under the dash and in confined spaces. The Automotive Electrical Technician must perform all tasks in a quality manner, in the proper sequence, in the time allotted. He/she will also assess, propose, and implement improvements to manufacturing methods and processes.

- Installation of electrical components
- Testing and validation of electrical components and systems
- Assist in developing engineering designs and implement engineering changes
