

Job Description – Automotive Body Senior Technician

Summary Statement

The Automotive Body Senior Technician assembles new reproduction automobile bodies.

Description

The Automotive Body Senior Technician assembles new automobile unibodies with new reproduction and fabricated parts, fits and gaps body panels, and prepares bodies for paint. The Automotive Body Senior Technician performs spot and GMAW welding and uses conventional body work hand tools to shape and fit metal. The Automotive Body Senior Technician also fits exterior trim, glass and mechanisms, door and trunk closures, convertible top frames, and other components.

Duties and Tasks Performed Critical to Success

The Automotive Body Senior Technician must be proficient in spot and GMAW welding, working with steel and fiberglass body panels, metal shaping, and general automotive fabrication. The Automotive Body Senior Technician will work inside, around, and under the vehicle as required to perform the designated tasks. The Automotive Body Senior Technician will also assess, propose, and implement improvements to manufacturing methods and processes.
