

Job Description – Automotive Final Assembly and Quality Control Senior Technician

Summary Statement

The Automotive Final Assembly and Quality Control Senior Technician performs final assembly and quality control inspection of new production automobiles.

Description

The Automotive Final Assembly and Quality Control Senior Technician performs final assembly of new production automobiles with new reproduction, OEM, and aftermarket parts, using proper tools and procedures. The Automotive Final Assembly and Quality Control Senior Technician installs painted body panels, exterior and interior trim, performs final adjustments to latches, closures, glass, and weatherstrip, and test drives vehicles to ensure they are free of squeaks and rattles and all components function perfectly.

Duties and Tasks Performed Critical to Success

The Automotive Final Assembly and Quality Control Senior Technician must be proficient in fitting a variety of automobile parts to a painted vehicle body, while taking great care to protect the painted finish and all Class A surfaces. The Automotive Final Assembly and Quality Control Senior Technician must understand how to diagnose and correct noise, vibration, and harshness (NVH) concerns such as squeaks and rattles and wind noise. The Automotive Final Assembly and Quality Control Senior Technician will work closely with Engineering to assess, propose, and implement improvements to product design and manufacturing methods and processes to improve vehicle quality.

- Fitting exterior and interior trim
- Fitting glass and mechanisms, door and trunk closures, and convertible top frames
- Fitting weatherstrip and ensuring proper body sealing
- Diagnosing and correcting NVH concerns
- Assist in implementing engineering changes to improve quality
